It is accepted that health and safety has two distinct groups of costs when an incident occurs, those that are insured and those that are not. What may surprise you is the ratio of these costs

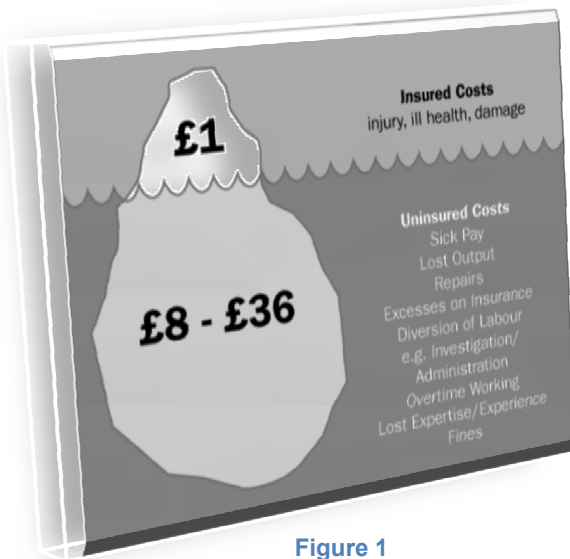
